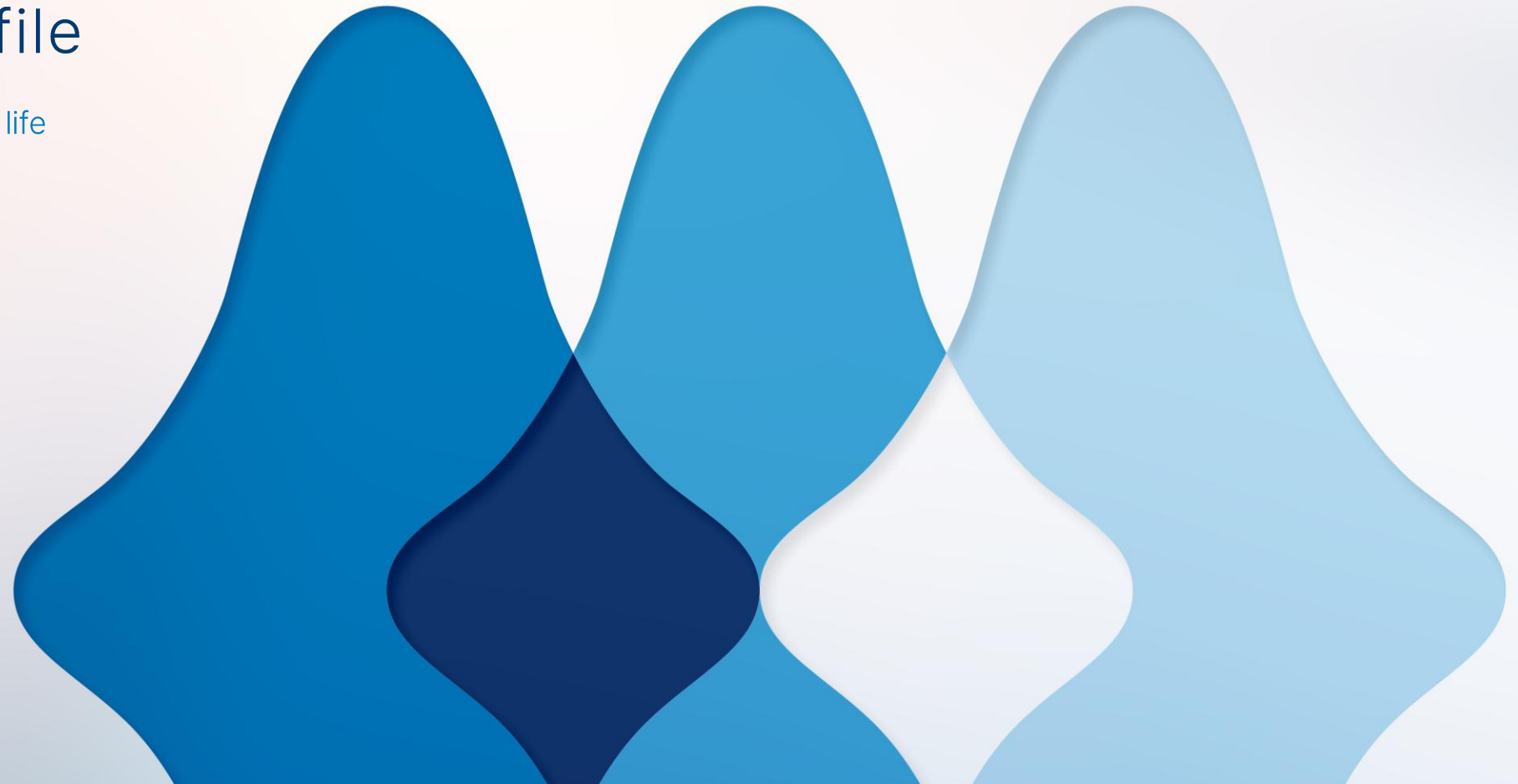

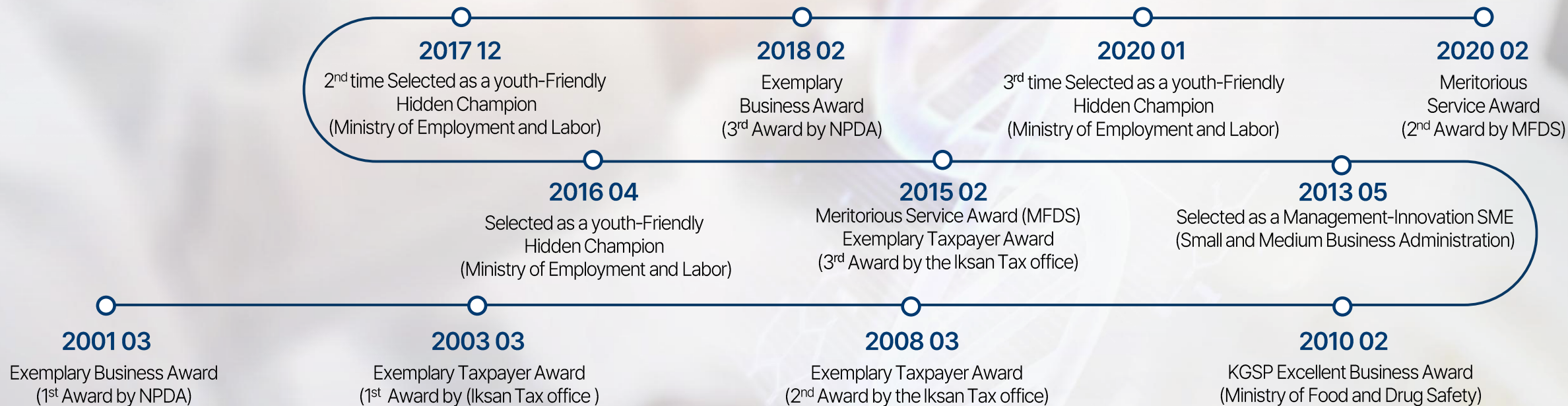

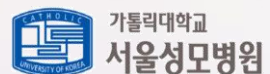

Contributed to sales growth by being designated as cooperative firm with multinational companies

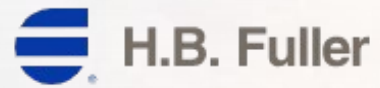

2-octyl cyanoacrylate Topical Skin Adhesive

- Forms a protective barrier and helps maintain moisture at the wound site
- SurgiSeal Teardrop model approved in 2010; SurgiSeal Stylus model approved in 2022.

FDA approved 2-octyl cyanoacrylate adhesive for VAD securement

- Used to secure vascular access catheters
- Prevents moisture and bacteria from entering the catheter insertion site
- Reduces the risk of infection
- Protects the skin around the insertion site

Paxman Scalp Cooling System

- A scalp cooling system designed to prevent chemotherapy-induced alopecia during systemic chemotherapy
- By maintaining the coolant at -4°C to cool the scalp, it may help reduce drug delivery to the hair follicles during chemotherapy
- The system consists of the main unit, cooling hose, cooling cap, and cap cover



HUMOST FIT

- Sterilized patient gown
- An elastic compression band designed to support and hold body parts for faster postoperative recovery
- A surgical drape that cover the operative site to protect it from contamination and does not come into direct contact with the wound or internal tissue
- OEM production and nationwide sales network established; HUMOST FIT approved in 2024
- Currently supplied and sold mainly to general hospitals and specialized surgical hospitals in Korea



Silicone Wound Contact Layer

- An open-mesh adherent wound dressing used to protect the wound
- Soft, atraumatic silicone gel that reduces potential skin trauma and minimizes pain during dressing removal
- MFDS Approved in 2018

Mobile Ultrasound Imaging System

- A Mobile ultrasound imaging system for non-invasive, real-time diagnosis of internal organs
- Multi mode :Colour Doppler Mode and Power Doppler Mode
- The device consists of a touchscreen main unit and a probe

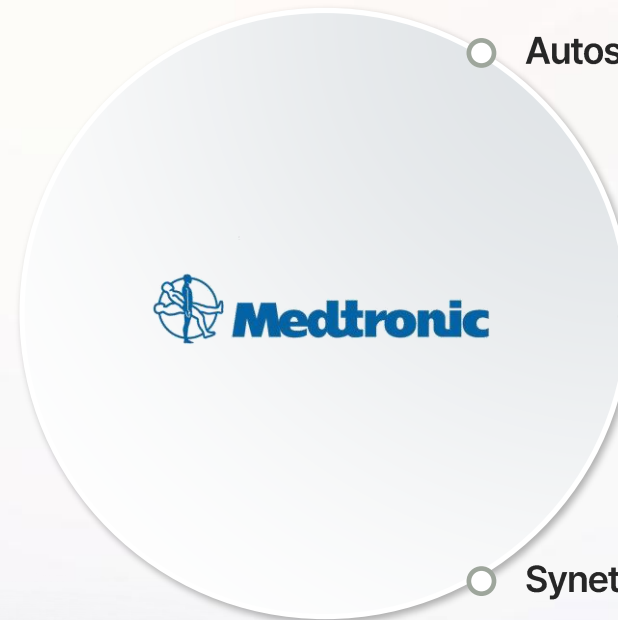
